Wildland Type 6 Brush Truck Replacement

Description: This brush truck replacement allows the department to meet the continued wildland fire threat and providing the best firefighting resource. The truck will increase our current capability of carrying two firefighters with our current extended cab brush truck, to carrying our normal crew of three with a four-door cab. This brush truck will be built to meet our current two brush trucks allowing for the same capabilities' crews are used to having. It's improved size of a one-ton truck allows our ability to carry more water than our earlier trucks. This truck will match our current truck size.



Justification: Following a department replacement plan for apparatus, this 2000 F350 extended cab truck has served the community well, this truck will improve our abilities in however improvements in our crew staffing, improved water carrying capabilities and improved equipment storage. This truck will be placed in service at the new fire station upon its completion. We have secured special pricing from purchases made by Pueblo County recently and have saved the District in the process.
